

Fulshear Parks Commission Minutes 7.11.14

The meeting was called to order at 9:04 a.m.

A quorum was established.

- I. Tajana made a motion to approve the June minutes. Elizabeth seconded.
- II. CJ McDaniel was introduced as a new Commissioner.
- III. Tajana reported that Enchanted Gardens will begin plant installation on the Pollinator Garden on July 30th and should take 2 days. Ramona reported that William Casey's son will be building a bench for the garden as an Eagle Scout project. Friends of Fulshear Parks and a local Girl Scout troop have volunteered to help with maintaining the garden.
- IV. CJ Snipes informed the Commissioners that we will have a budget workshop at our Aug. 8th meeting. The Commissioners were asked to look over Sec.6 of the Comprehensive Plan, to cross reference it with the table on Sec.4 and to bring ideas of what should be implemented Year 1, Year 2, Year 3, etc.
- V. Ethics training will be held on Saturday, August 9th at the Irene Stern Center. All Commissioners, Committee members and City employees are required to attend.
- VI. CJ Snipes will be in negotiations for 116 acres on Monday.
- VII. Tajana reported that there were approximately 15 Friends of Fulshear Parks members who participated in the Freedom Fest parade by handing out wildflower seed packets. Tajana will contact Tammy, a CCR employee, to investigate the possibility of passing out wildflower seeds at the CCR Welcome Center on a continuing basis as an awareness project for the Parks Commission.
- VIII. Ramona reported from Forever Fulshear that the Bike Barn volunteers picked up about 30 large trash bags of debris along Bois d'Arc in the latest effort. Also, that Forever Fulshear will be opening a Fulshear Farmers' Market in August.
