

Fulshear Parks Commission Regular Meeting 2/20/15

Members present: Dave Bundrick, CJ McDaniel, Ramona Ridge, Tajana Mesic, and Elizabeth Voss

The meeting was called to order at 9:10 a.m.

Minutes from the last meeting were approved.

There was a quorum present.

I. Forever Fulshear will be April 11th. Ramona Ridge reported about 100 people attended last event. Clean up would be along FM 1093 from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.

II. Ramona Ridge led discussion on the Butterfly Garden Plaque with CJ McDaniel indicating the best option was to put bronze plaques on Boulders.

III. Elizabeth Voss presented information about Butterfly Garden Mural on the concrete block restrooms. The cost to have a local art teacher supply supplies and artwork would be \$1500 to paint all four sides, using design suggestions from local elementary students with a competition at Huggins and Wertheimer. Elizabeth Voss would report the suggestion from the art teacher and schools at the next meeting. Ramona Ridge would check with her art friends and possibly Rotary club for involvement.

IV. CJ McDaniel reported a White Water Center is about \$39 million to build and \$7 million/year to maintain. Land acquisition would determine the extent of what we could do. We agreed to keep this discussion going.

V. Lynn Raymer reported on the business card design and cost plus had examples of color samples from Fulshear Graphics. It was moved and seconded then voted to approve the design and order.

VI. A Spring Event for the Butterfly and Pollinator Garden was discussed. It was moved by CJ McDaniel and seconded by Ramona Ridge to hold the event the last weekend of April. This motion was passed.

VII. CJ McDaniel reported that the bench was almost ready.

VIII. Possible agenda topics for next month included the McCann property and the Chamber director visiting.

The meeting was motioned for adjournment and the motion passed at 10:15 a.m.
