

## Fulshear Parks Commission Regular Meeting 3/27/15

Members present: Ramona Ridge, Dave Bundrick, CJ McDaniel, Elizabeth Voss

CJ Snipes was present for approximately 10 minutes before leaving

Meeting called to order at 9:07 a.m.

The minutes were approved as written.

There was a quorum present.

1. Ramona Ridge gave an update on the Forever Fulshear Event to clean up along 1093 as well as the Community Garden that will be enlarged at that event. Also some electronics recycling will be available.
2. Dave Bundrick requested the parks commission look at Francis Smart Park for a dress-up and clean-up for more uses including a skate park. More research into the usage for the park or parks was needed to address this possibility as well as other uses.
3. CJ McDaniel reported on different signage possibilities at the Butterfly/Pollinator Park at Irene Stern. Samples were passed around for inspection and suggestions.
4. CJ McDaniel also reported that Boy Scout Garden Bench project had not been started due to incomplete funding.
5. Cheryl Finney spoke to the possibility of incorporating horse trails in the parks system when trails became available. Elizabeth Voss suggested that talking with the pipeline company that crisscrosses several of the Ranches in the area could be a possible trail source which had been seen in The Villages of Indian Lakes in College Station. CJ McDaniel suggested that horse enthusiasts form a group to present proposals to interested parties such as the pipeline and parks.
6. A later update was to be presented on various properties that could include relationships with the parks system.
7. A discussion of the approaching Grand Opening of the Irene Stern Butterfly/Pollinator Garden included the fact that the Artwalk was being held on the same Saturday April 25 which might help draw attention to the Garden too.
8. Lynn Raymer was thanked for getting the Parks business cards which members were very pleased to have.
9. Elizabeth Voss presented ideas and recommendations for the garden mural. Ramona Ridge will be getting some artists besides the art teacher at Wertheimer to present ideas for the mural. CJ McDaniel suggested possibly a retainer be given the artist selected.

The meeting was motioned for adjournment and the motion approved at 10:48 a.m.

Items for the Agenda next month included discussion and possible action on garden signage, discussion and possible action on garden mural, discussion and possible action on Grand Opening Event, discussion of Frances Smart Park, a look at the financials, and Executive Session after the April Meeting.
