








Regular meeting dates based upon the third Tuesday of each month

Time Line



- Consider and Adopt
 Criteria and Guidelines
 Resolution and Time Line
 (Today)
- Presentation on
 Redistricting Principles,
 Initial Assessment, and
 Designate Council
 Representatives (August 30)
- Develop Illustrative Plan(s)(September 1-15)

- Designate Illustrative Plan(s) (September 20)
- Public Comment Period and Public Hearings (Late September through Mid October)
- Illustrative Plan(s) Report and Possible Revisions (October 18)
- Adopt Districting Plan (November 15)
- Election Preparation (After November 15 through February 17)



Redistricting Criteria

- Where possible, use easily identifiable geographic boundaries
- Be mindful of the location of municipal facilities within the City
- Facilitate practical voting precincts and adequate facilities for polling places
- Districts configured to be relatively equal in total population based on the 2010 census and any adjustments to that data.
- Deviation should not exceed 10%



Redistricting Criteria

- Consider incumbent-constituency relations and historical representation.
- Design compact and contiguous districts.
- Narrowly tailor the plan to address VRA considerations
- Avoid fragmenting any geographically compact minority community or pack minority voters



Redistricting Guidelines

Proposed Plans:

- Submitted in writing and be legible
- Show all demographic and racial categories based upon the 2010 Census
- Plans should redistrict the entire City of Fulshear
- Plans should conform to the criteria
- Comments must be submitted in writing and be legible
- Comments and proposed plans must include person's full name and home address and provide a phone number and, if available, an email address
- All comments and proposed plans must be submitted to the City Council by the close of the public hearing
