MAY 16, 2013

### I. CALL TO ORDER

C. J. Snipes, City Administrator, stated that Planning and Zoning Commission approved Lazy J plat contingent on that the street dedication be made to the City by school district before final approval. Mr. James already has a permanent entry to his property and has no way to make Lamar C.I.S. D. consent to the street dedication. However, representatives from L.C.I.S.D stated that the street dedication is in the works. There was some discussion concern the dedication of the road to the City. The developer does not have full authority over the road and it is actually the school district. Through the discussion, it was agreed that the developer should not be accountable.

There was a 15 minute discussion among Council Members and the building inspector regarding definition for "street turn radius knuckles". Ms. Morris, Building Inspector, stated it would make those places with several drivers coming out at the same time a lot safer. This new term would be identified in all new development agreements to allow in situations where "street turn radius knuckles" required. Two diagrams were presented to Council to identify the difference.

**H. CONSIDERATION and POSSIBLE ACTION to AWARD BID for RESTROOM INSTALLATION PROJECT at IRENE STERN PARK**

*C. J. Snipes, City Administrator, stated that this is the second time that this project has gone out for bids. Four packets were requested but only two submitted bids. One bid was not responsive due to some technical failures but the other bid is good. However, that bid is more than what was budgeted for the project but the contractor has agreed for us to the bid for a 120 days to allows us to make a budget adjustment or to plan in next year's budget. Mr. Snipes stated that actually this bid is \$18,000.00 less from the first time. He stated we went with a design that would be extremely low maintenance and durability.*

*A motion was made by Alderman Beustring to accept recommendation made by City Engineer, David Leyendecker, (award bid to Wallis Concrete for restroom installation project at Irene Stern Park). It was seconded by Alderman Collins. The motion was carried by the following vote:*

Mayor Kuykendall expressed that this particular plat has been a thorn in his side. This is an entity that came in and there were a tremendous amount of issues with the platting process. He stated that Michelle has bent over backwards to accommodate and now the plat is meeting requirements. However, they City has reviewed hundreds of plats and found it rather insulting as I (Mayor Kuykendall) got calls from the County Commissioner and State Representative with what 's wrong with the plat. I had to explain our platting system. We actually visited with Firethorne and they also had a number of issues with this plat. Mayor Kuykendall stated to the representative for CVS plat that he know he has been sent to bare the ,, of the comments but he wished the gentlemen who kept sending e-mails was present but he guess he has gone back to Louisiana. The firm that is doing this project is from Louisiana and maybe this is part of the problem. Mayor Kuykendall expressed that maybe next time there will be competent people available.

Attorney Tim Kirwin stated that a letter was sent to the company asking them to be available for the meeting tonight to express any concerns that they might have had.

A motion was made by Alderman Gill to approve CVS #10177 FM 1463 and S. Firethorne Rd/ Final Plat. It was seconded by Alderman Beustring. The motion was carried by the following vote:

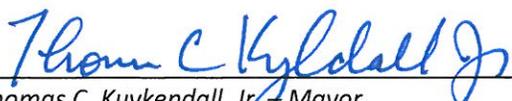
X. ADJOURNMENT

A motion was made by Alderman Collins to adjourn at 8:17 p.m. It was seconded by Alderwoman Patterson. The motion was carried by the following vote:

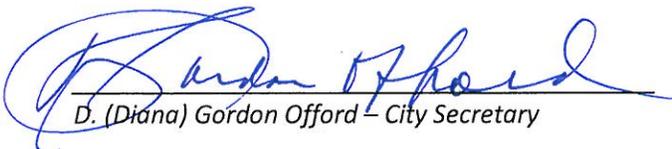
