



Recycle Pickup Specifications

CITY OF FULSHEAR

Dear City of Fulshear Resident,

We look forward to providing your household recycle program with your new, yellow-lid, 95-gallon recycle cart.

1. Recycle pickup day: Wednesday between the hours of 7:00 am and 7:00 pm. Place your recycle cart at least 3 feet from your trash cart.
2. Place excess recyclables in see-thru plastic bags or cardboard boxes beside the recycle cart.
3. Your first recycle pickup day using 95-gallon carts will be Wednesday, February 5th, 2014, and thereafter, every Wednesday
4. Royal will provide one 95 gallon recycle cart per residence. Extra carts may be requested and will be billed directly to the homeowner for \$5 per month.
5. Please have your recyclables at the curb by 7 a.m. on collection day.
6. HOLIDAYS: New Year's Day, Memorial Day, July 4th, Labor Day, Thanksgiving, and Christmas Day. If a holiday occurs on a scheduled recycle day, the recyclables will be picked up on the Saturday following the observed holiday.

Recycling is Easy with our yellow-lid 95-Gallon Cart. Wheels make it easy to roll and the hinged lid keeps recycle inside the cart until collection.

RECYCLE

Aluminum Products: beverage cans, cooking containers, drink pouches, foil, plates

Cardboard: boxes, cereal boxes, gift boxes, packaging, flatten large boxes

Glass Products: clear and colored glass, bottles, containers

Metals: all cans and lids, beverage cans, food cans, pet food cans, storage containers

Paper: envelopes with/without windows, file folders, grocery bags, junk mail, lunch bags, magazines and catalogs, newspaper and inserts, packing paper, phone books, shopping bags, white office paper, wrapping paper

Plastics: any product with recycle symbol 1 through 7 including water bottles, food containers or product packaging, milk jugs, buckets, Styrofoam (place packing pellets in plastic bag and puncture bag to prevent bag from exploding when compacted and blowing pellets into the street).

Plastic bags: bag the bags – place plastic bags inside one plastic bag and recycle if possible.

DO NOT RECYCLE

Cooking oil; disposable lighters; household hazardous products (dispose at designated recycle center);
