COMING UP WITH FUNDING TO FINANCE THE EXPANSION OF THE ROAD. (FOR ALL THE COMMENTS, REQUEST A COPY OF THE TAPE RECORDING)

MAYOR ROBERTS STATED THAT HE WOULD LIKE TO SEE THE EXPANSION OR WIDENING OF FM 1093 BUT DID NOT WANT A TOLL ROAD COMING THROUGH THE CITY. MAYOR ASKED FOR COMMENTS.

COUNCIL MEMBER KRENEK STATED SHE DOES NOT FEEL WE HAVE SUFFICIENT INFORMATION TO MAKE A DECISION. COUNCIL MEMBER KRENEK STATED THAT SHE WOULD LIKE A REVISION OF THE RESOLUTION (ITEMIZED SEVERAL AREAS, REQUEST COPY OF TAPE FOR ALL COMMENTS).

MR. SNIPES, CITY MANAGER, OUTLINED HOW THE TOLL ROAD WOULD BE CONSTRUCTED. COUNCIL MEMBER TRISTAN ASKED IF THERE WOULD BE FOUR LANES FROM SPRING GREEN TO JAMES LANE. THE DEBATE AMONG COUNCIL MEMBERS, MR. SNIPES, AND RICHARD FROM FORT BEND COUNTY ENGINEERING DEPARTMENT CONTINUED DISCUSSION REGARDING THE EXPANSION OF FM 1093. THE DISCUSSION ENDS WITH MORE QUESTIONS THAN ANSWERS. (FOR ALL THE COMMENTS, REQUEST A COPY OF THE TAPE RECORDING) COUNCIL MEMBER GILL ASKED MORE QUESTIONS AND THE DISCUSSION CONTINUED.

IT WAS ASKED IF COUNCIL MEMBER KRENEK HAD A MOTION. SHE STATED TO LET SOMEONE ELSE. COUNCIL MEMBER GILL STATED HE NEEDS MORE INFORMATION. COUNCIL MEMBER KRENEK STATED SHE THOUGHT THE CONVERSATION CAME UP A FEW YEARS AGO AND THIS WOULD NOT BE HAPPENING UNTIL 2025 AND LACKS INFORMATION TO MAKE A DECISION. MAYOR ROBERTS STATED THAT THIS RESOLUTION IS ASKED WHERE THE CITY STANDS. COUNCIL GILL RESTATED THAT HE DOES NOT HAVE ENOUGH INFORMATION TO MAKE A DECISION AND IF SOMEONE HAS THE INFORMATION PLEASE SHARE IT. COUNCIL MEMBER KRENEK STATED SHE DOES NOT HAVE ENOUGH INFORMATION WHETHER A TOLL ROAD WOULD BE BENEFICIAL OR NOT. COMMISSIONER MEYERS STATED THEY ARE LOOKING FOR ANSWERS. HE STATED DEVELOPERS IN TWO OTHER CITIES ARE LOOKING TO MAKING DECISIONS FOR THEIR CITIES AS THEY HAVE OVER 15,000 ACRES TO DEVELOP.

COMMISSIONER MEYERS ADMONISH THE CITY TO TAKE ALL THE TIME NEEDED TO MAKE A DECISION WHAT'S BEST FOR OUR COMMUNITY. HE REALIZE A TOLL ROAD COMING THROUGH A CITY IS A BIG DECISION. THE DISCUSSION CONTINUED.
