Risk Category for Food Establishments Effective 12/01/2025

- **High Risk** – An establishment that prepares and sell/serves potentially hazardous food, such as, but not limited to: restaurants, cafeterias, fast-food restaurants, mobile food units, schools, daycares, and grocery stores that prepackage potentially hazardous food on site.
- **Medium Risk** – An establishment that sells/serves pre-package potentially hazardous food and/or prepares limited types of food such as, but not limited to: convenience stores that heat and serve deli type food (hot dogs, sausage, etc.) and/or package ice.
- **Low Risk** – An establishment that sells/serves only prepackaged no-potentially hazardous food or whole uncut produce such as but not limited to: convenience stores, bars, farmer's markets, and establishments that serve only prepackaged, non-potentially hazardous food.

***Potentially Hazardous Food** is any food that consists in whole or in part of milk or milk products, eggs, meat, poultry, shellfish, edible crustacean, or other ingredients including synthetic ingredients, in a form capable of supporting rapid progressive growth of infectious or toxigenic microorganisms. The term does include clean, whole uncracked, odor-free shell eggs. The term does not include foods, which have a pH level of 4.6 or below, or a water activity (Aw) value of 0.85 or less.
