The City adopted a new ordinance in response to a rise in collisions and near-misses involving vehicles and sidewalk users, and are designed to improve safety throughout the community.

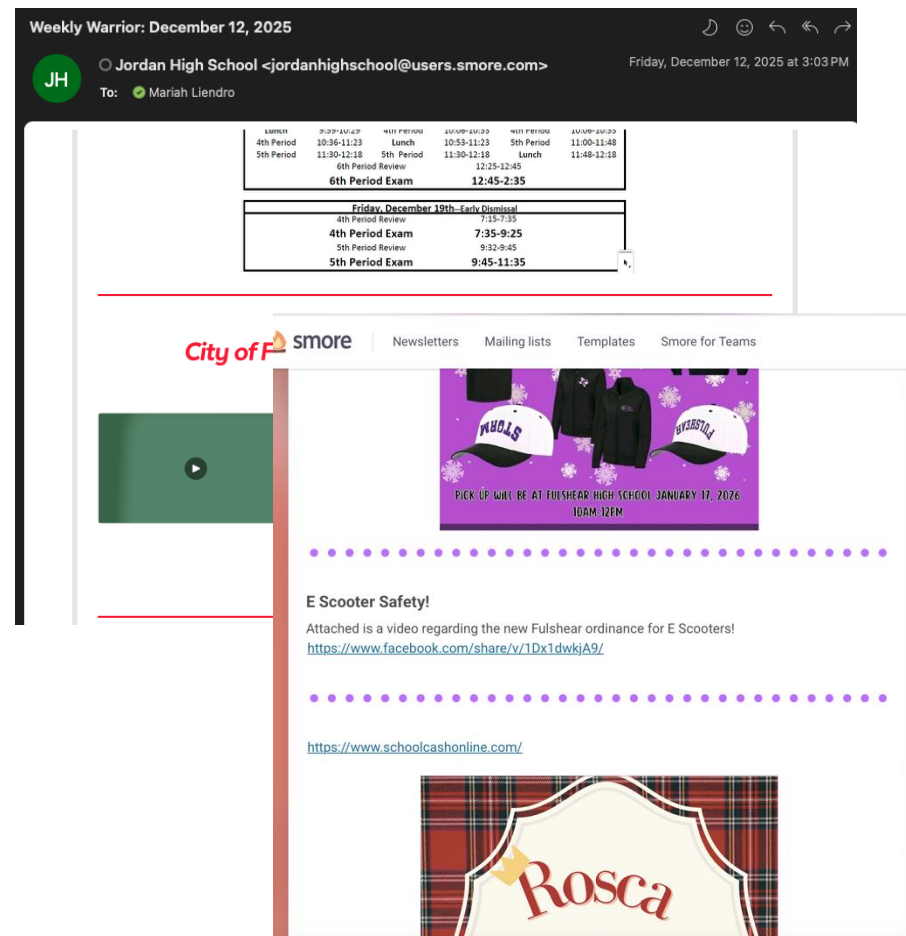
What You Need to Know

- Riders must use sidewalks whenever one is available
- Riders must come to a complete stop before crossing a street and follow pedestrian right-of-way rules
- Children under 15 must follow these rules under the supervision of a parent or guardian
- It is unlawful to cling to or attach a scooter or bicycle to a moving vehicle

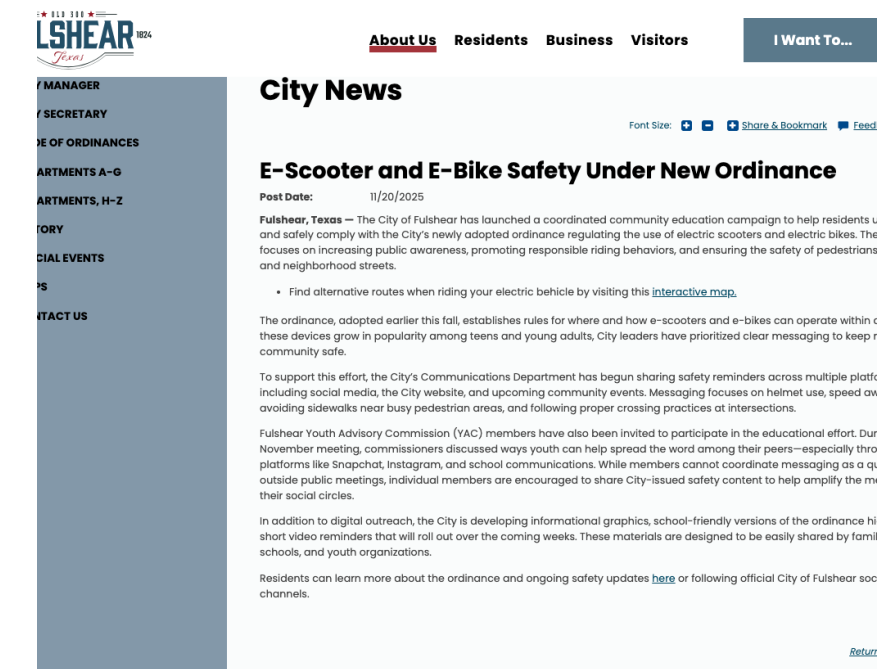

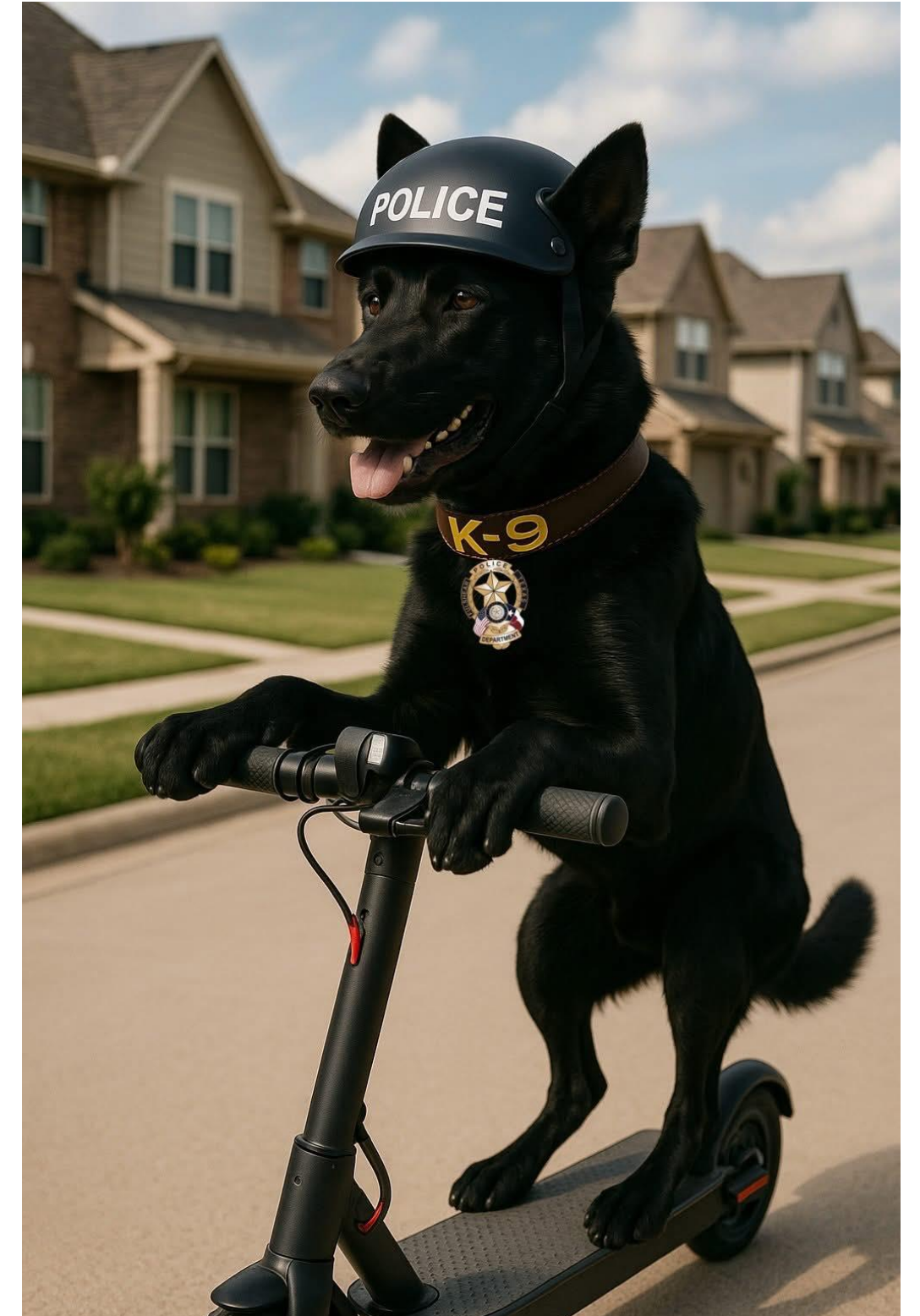
