WILDLIFE IMPACT Study

- **Presentation by Joshua Brothers - Executive Director of Planning**

Joshua Brothers, Planning Director of the City of Fulshear, presented a draft wildlife impact study ordinance to The Parks & Recreation Commission affecting future residential developments. The ordinance as presented would require a wildlife impact study to be done by developers for any development on 50 acres or more. After discussion with the commission the consensus was to lower the acreage to 15 acres instead of 50 acres.

The Chamber for Commerce will be hosting a big America 250 celebration as well that the city is sponsoring their drone show.

For the 2026 payment it would be \$10,000 and then \$5,000 in 2027 and \$5,000

in 2028. Kelly Ravsten, Recreation & Events Coordinator, to reach out to Memorial Hermann to see if this request works for them.

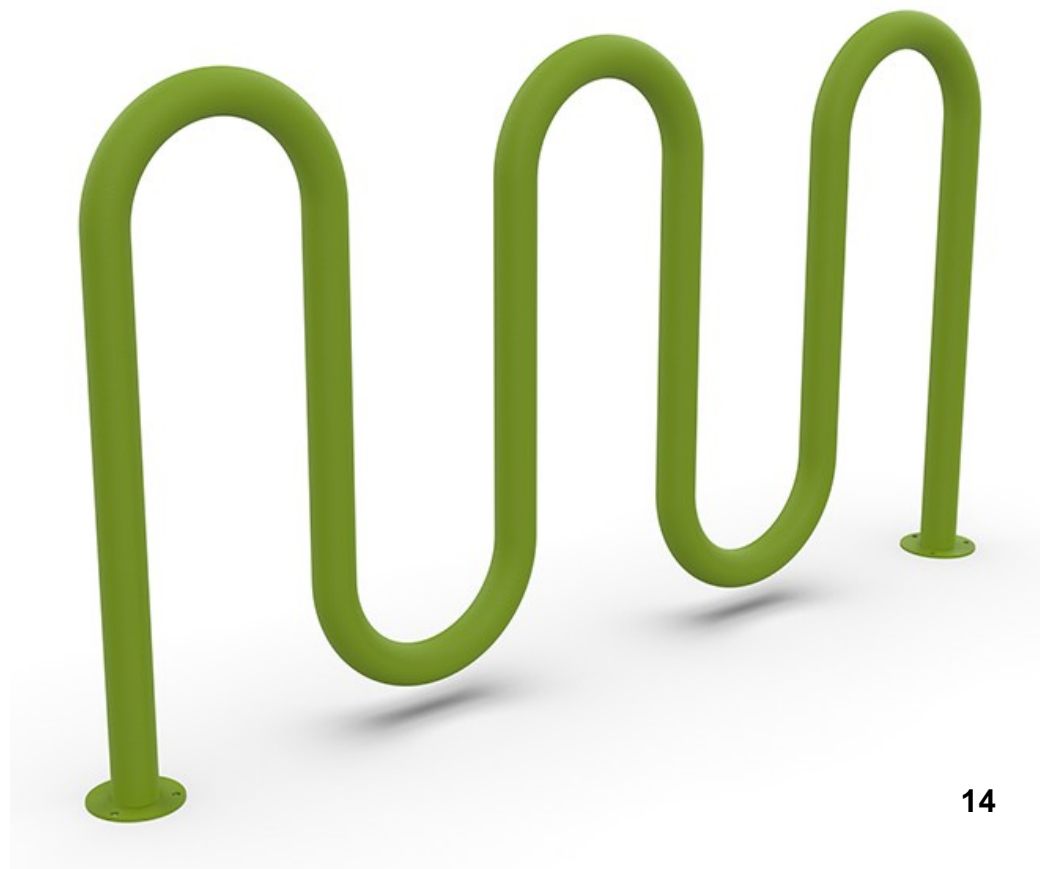
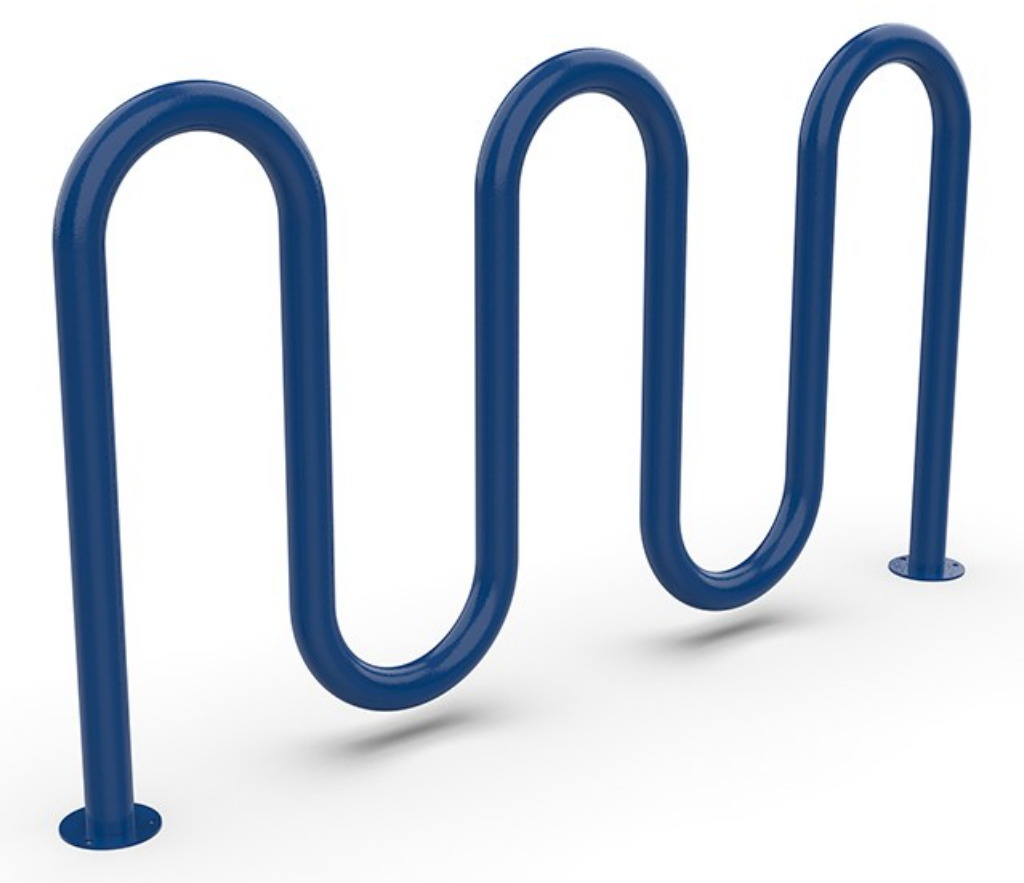


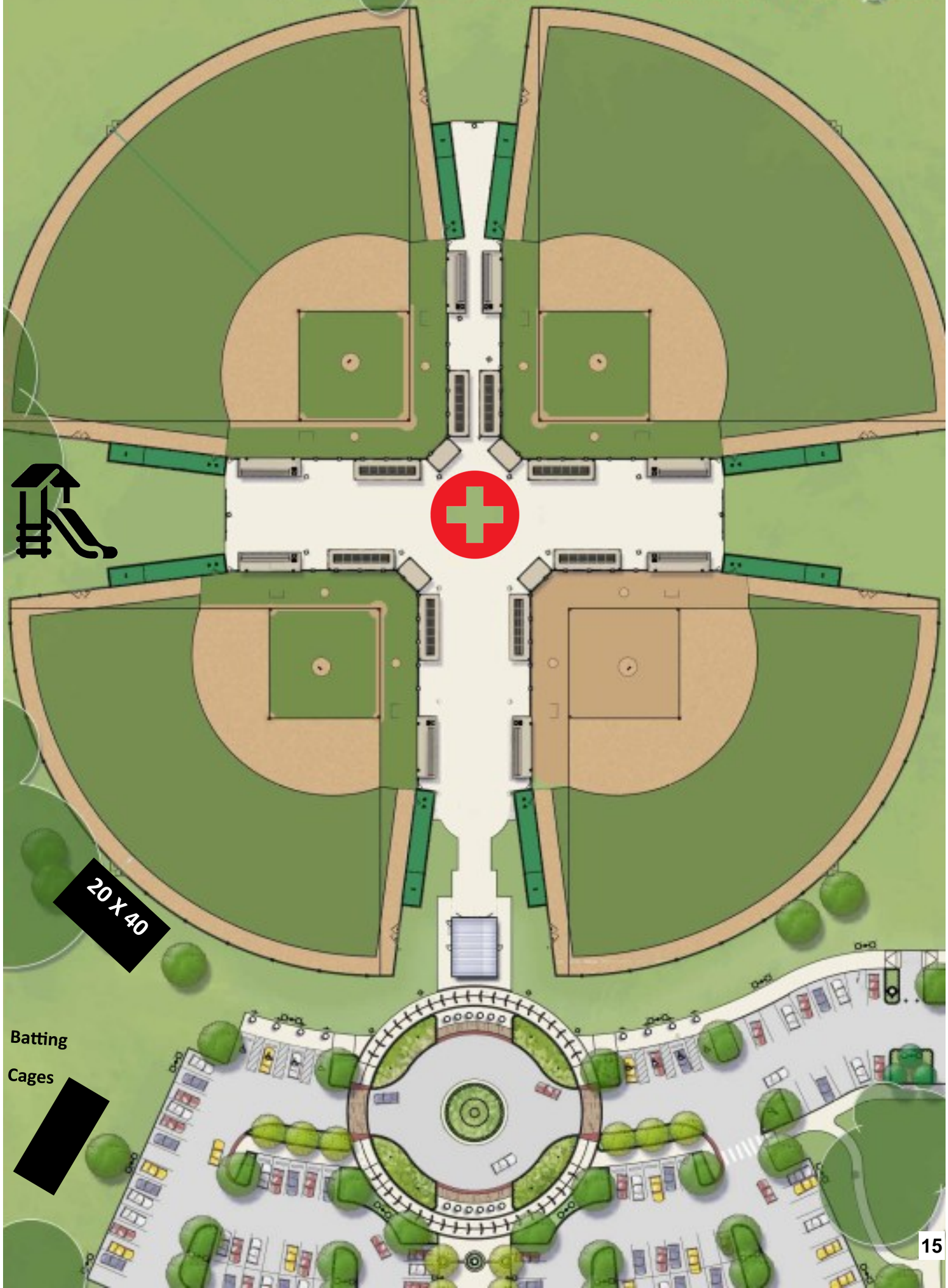
